

What is Consumer-Directed Care Plus?



Consumer-Directed Care Plus (CDC+) places participants in the driver's seat. Individuals have more choice, flexibility, and control over their care. CDC+ consumers become employers with the ability to choose what services and supports they need and who will provide them.

Key Features of CDC+

Participant Empowerment: Individuals are empowered to make decisions pertaining to their supports and have the flexibility to determine, choose, and pay for services through a monthly budget.

Choice of Service Provider: The program provides individuals with unique benefits such as the ability to select providers who are not on the Medicaid network and the ability to customize services to meet individual care goals.

Supports: A trained CDC+ consultant is always available to provide guidance and assistance.

Management Options: Participants can choose to manage the program on their own or appoint a representative to assist in managing their budget and help make decisions regarding their care.
