

APD's COVID-19 Information Tracker

In our continued effort to ensure that our staff, providers, clients, and other stakeholders are provided with the most up-to-date information concerning COVID-19, the agency has created the COVID-19 Information Tracker.

The Tracker, which is updated daily, monitors information about COVID-19 released by the following six government agencies:

- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC);
- Executive Office of the Governor (GOV);
- Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD);
- Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA);
- Department of Health (DOH); and
- Division of Emergency Management (DEM)

Color Coding: Each of the six state agencies has been assigned a different color for easy identification in the spreadsheet.

Column Headings: The **Date**, **Time**, and specific **Agency** from which the information was released is noted. The **Category/Type** column includes a short description of the information included. The **Title** of the information is included, as well as the **Applicability** of the information. Finally, a **Link** to the full article or information is inserted.

Searching the Spreadsheet: Each column has a Down Arrow beside it at the top beside the title. For example, if you click on the Down Arrow next to **Agency**, you will see a window with all the agency abbreviations included in the spreadsheet. If you would like to just view AHCA entries, unclick "Select All"; then click "AHCA". Then click "OK". This sorting feature can be done for any of the columns but is most effective for the **Date**, **Agency**, and **Category/Type** columns.

Please Note: The information is placed in an excel workbook consisting of two spreadsheets. The first spreadsheet contains the Information Tracker itself, while the second spreadsheet contains COVID-19 State Agency Websites with specific Coronavirus information pertaining to each state agency.
