## EFFECTIVE DATE: INFORMATIONAL - RULE WORKSHOP NOTICE

The Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) is committed to a successful implementation of chapter 2020-71, Laws of Florida, effective July 1, 2021. To ensure success, APD will be communicating with Waiver Support Coordinators (WSCs) throughout the implementation process. A second rule workshop for chapter 65G-14, F.A.C., Qualified Organizations and Waiver Support Coordination, is scheduled for November 18, 2020 at 10 a.m. EST and will be held by webinar. This workshop is being held to provide members of the public the opportunity to give input on the draft rules for chapter 65G-14, F.A.C.
